


# Quick Tips to get started Tracker App

1. Download the Beanstack Tracker App from either the App Store (Apple) or Google Play (Android).

The first screen that you will see is the following screen.




2. Click on Yup!


3. The second screen will look like this. Click in the *Find a Site* box.



4. Then type Casey Cardinia into the *Beanstack GO* box.




5. Next you can either *Sign In* to your Beanstack account (if you already have one), or Create an Account by clicking on *Sign-up!* below the blue Sign In button.




6. This is the Home Screen.


If you scroll down the page you will get an overview of your account: recent titles logged, current challenges you are participating in, my badges (earned), my activities (completed), and my reviews.




7. To add *Readers* to your account, the *Account Creator* (you) will click on the Account Cog and then the *Readers* option. You can also edit your personal information here.



8. Add as many additional *Readers* as needed by clicking on *Add A Reader*.




9. To switch between *Readers* in an account, simply click on the circular icon in the top right-hand corner. This icon will display the initials of the *Account Creator / Reader*. Then select which *Reader's* account you want to accesss.




10. To find available reading challenges, click on the *Discover* icon (next to the yellow plus symbol).




11. The yellow + icon is the fastest way to log reading, activities or book reviews. It has changed to a red cross in this image.



12.Once you select what you want to log, you will be asked to select which *Reader/s* you want to log for. One of the great features of Beanstack is the ability for the *Account Creator* to log the same book for multiple *Readers*. Also, if a *Reader* is enrolled in multiple reading challenges, any book logged will be registered in the multiple challenges. We love this feature!



13. You will then be prompted to select the method for logging your reading. Another cool feature is the ability to scan the book's barcode (ISBN).



14.The *Log* icon will give you an overview of what you have logged in the reading challenge. Tabs include: Recent, Completed, Badges (Earned), Reviews (submitted) & Highlights.
