Link **medicare** to **myGov** with your Medicare card

Step 1: Sign in to myGov at my.gov.au

myGov is a simple and secure way to access online government services.



Note: You may be asked to agree to myGov storing your personal details. This will happen if you haven't linked either the Australian Taxation Office or Centrelink to your myGov.

Select 'I Agree' to accept myGov storing your personal details.

Step 3: Make sure your details match.

Make sure your details match

⚠ To link Medicare, your details recorded with myGov must match your details in Medicare.

Your details in myGov are:

Given names: **John**

Family name: **CITIZEN**

Date of birth: **01/05/1980**

If your details, including your legal name, don't match, you'll need to update them.

To do this in:

- Medicare, contact Medicare
- myGov, contact the Australian Taxation Office or Centrelink.

Cancel Continue

Select 'Continue'

If your name is already recorded in myGov, it needs to match your name recorded with Medicare.

If they don't match, you'll need to update your details.

If your myGov name needs updating, contact Centrelink or the ATO. If your Medicare name needs updating, call Medicare.

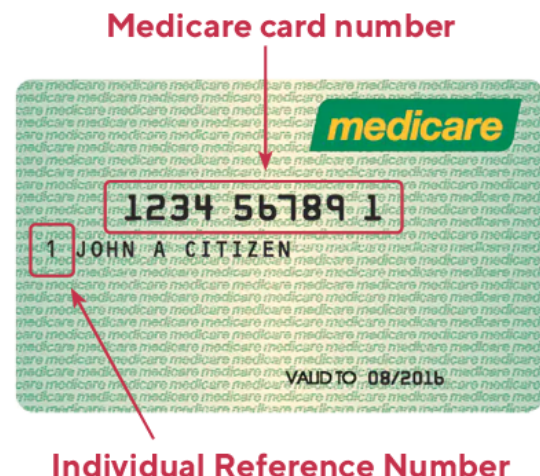
Step 4: Select 'I'm listed on a Medicare card'

Step 5: Enter your personal details.

You'll be asked to enter your:

- Medicare card number
- Individual Reference Number
- Name
- Date of birth
- Address

You'll also be asked about details given to Medicare in the past.



Step 6: Select 'Next'. Your accounts are now linked.
