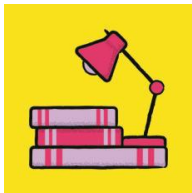




Find My Past

Find My Past is a genealogical site to research family history through. It has access to over 50 million records. This resource is only available in the library through the Wi-Fi or public computers.

Step by step process

1. Visit library website: connectedlibraries.org.au
2. Select Online Resources
3. Select Find My Past



4. Start your research

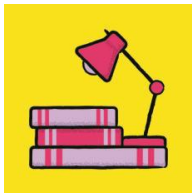
